JUNE 5. DAY 1.

Arrive in Florence. In the afternoon enjoy a **guided tour of Florence** with entrances to the the Duomo (Cattedrale di Santa Maria del Fiore), Galleria dell'Accademia (Michelangelo's David). In the evening enjoy a welcome dinner at a local restaurants.

JUNE 6. DAY 2.

Continue tour of Florence with private guide.



JUNE 7. DAY 3.

Board your private coach bus for an **excursion to San Gimignano**. Your private guide will accompany you in the historic and beautiful town center. Known as the Town of Fine Towers, San Gimignano is famous for its [medieval architecture](#), unique in the preservation of about a dozen of its tower houses, which, with its hilltop setting and encircling walls, form an unforgettable skyline.

Wine, oil, and cheese tasting experience. The vineyard visit will begin with an in-depth explanation of the production and history in the vineyard. Wine tastings will include Vernaccia di San Gimignano DOCG and Chianti Colli Senesi DOCG.



JUNE 8. DAY 4.

Board your coach bus for the **Righini private car collection**. The collection includes historic cars from every car company: Ferrari, Mercedes Benz, Isotta Fraschini, Rolls Royce, with the stars of the show, classic Alfa Romeo cars.

Arrive in Parma and enjoy the afternoon at your own leisure.

JUNE 9. DAY 5.

Visit the **Pagani Museum and Factory**. The cars stay on display opposite the engines and models. At the time of this visit, a [Zonda R](#), a Zonda Cinque, "La Nonna" (the Pagani prototype used as a test bed for all Zondas that came afterwards and racked up over 600,000 miles), a Zonda S coupé and a RHD Zonda S Roadster, a Zonda F and a Huayra were all on display.

After your visit to Pagani you will experience a food making demonstration of a typical dish from Emilia-Romagna. Learn the secrets from the locals. Afterwards enjoy a lunch prepared for you at an agriturismo (Italian farmhouse).



JUNE 10. DAY 6.

Board your coach bus for Dallara. **Visit Dallara in Varano de Melegari**, near Parma, for a guided tour. Dallara was founded in 1972 by Giampaolo Dallara, which has become a leader in the design and production of racing car chassis, so much so that it is present in the Formula 3 championship and is the sole supplier for GP2, GP3, Formula V8 3.5, and Super Formula.



JUNE 11. DAY 7.

Starting ceremonies of the Mille Miglia. Established in 1927 as a speed race the 1000 Miglia is today a regularity race for historic cars that starts in Brescia arrives in Rome and ends in Brescia. Enjoy lunch in the main town square and watch each participating car pass by as they start the race. The models eligible to take part in the 1000 Miglia are those of which at least one specimen took part in one edition of the historic 1000 Miglia that was held from 1927 to 1957.



In the afternoon enjoy a wine tasting experience on Lake Garda. **Visit the beautiful town of Sirmione on Lake Garda** near Verona. It is located at the very end of a thin peninsula stretching into the lake and the lake surrounds the town on three sides.



JUNE 12. DAY 8.

Visit the Nicolis Car Museum near Verona. With one of the most prestigious private collections in Italy and Europe, Museo Nicolis tells the story of 20th century technology and design. The masterpieces it contains are divided into 10 collections: period cars, bicycles, and motorbike. In the afternoon you will meet your local guide for a tour of Verona.
